Thailand PGA Tour categories, which are use to determine the starting fields for Thailand PGA Tour 2017 are detailed in the order below:

Your 2017 are detailed in the order below:
 Winners of the Thailand Tour Order of Merit, who are exempt for 3 (three) calendar years immediately following the year in which the title was won.

- Winners of multiple Thailand PGA Tour Tournaments in the same year, who are exempt for 2 (two) calendar years following the year in which the tournaments were won.
- 3. Winners of Thailand PGA Tour Tournaments, who are exempt for 1 (one) calendar year following the year in which the tournament was won.
- 4. 16 Invitations from Thailand PGA
- Any member who finishes top 5 in a Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit Tournament in the current season, will be exempted into the next immediate Thailand PGA Tour Tournament in the same season. (tied for 5th position will decide by matching score cards)
- 6. Top 40 players (& ties) from 2016Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit.
- 7. Top 20 players (& ties) from Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit 2017 Re-ranking
- 8. Top 5 & ties from 2016 Thailand PGA Challenge Tour Order of Merit
- 9. Foreign Members
 - 9.1 $\,\bar{\text{Top}}$ 5 and ties from 2016 Thailand PGA Tour Final Order of Merit
 - 9.2 Top 5 and ties from Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit 2017 Re-ranking
 - 9.3 Top 5 from Qualifying Round (tied for 5th position from qualifying round will decide by matching score cards, the total score of all players in this category must not exceed 30th position of category 10 below).
- 10. Top 30 players from the Qualifying Round (tie for 30^{th} position will decide by matching score cards).
- 11. $41^{st} 60^{th}$ pos. from 2016 Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit.
- 12. $21^{st} 40^{th}$ positions from 2017 Thailand PGA Tour Order of Merit Re-ranking.
- 31st pos. and below from the Thailand PGA Tour Qualifying Round until the field is achieved as determined by the Tournament Committee (tie for the last eligible position will decide by matching score cards)
- Ordinary and Extraordinary members of Thailand PGA, determined by the Tournament Committee.

Notes:

- 1. Matching Score card means matching for the better score of the last 18, 9, 6, 3 holes respectively, if still tie, hole by hole matching count back from hole 18.
- 2. The above categories may be revised.
- 3. In all cases, the Tournament Committee Decisions are FINAL.
